PUBLIC HOUSING NOTICE

Effective, Monday, September 11, 2017 at 8:30 A.M. and continuing until further notice, the Flint Housing Commission (FHC) will OPEN the Two Bedroom Low-Income Public Housing Waiting List (This is NOT Section 8).

Priority for admission will be given to applicants 18 years or older who qualify for one or more of FHC's local preferences (pending verification by FHC):

- Working for 6 months consistently without interruptions
- Elderly (62 yrs. & older)
- Disabled
- Involuntarily Displaced due to disaster (fire, flood, earthquake, etc.), Federal, State, or local government action related to code enforcement, public improvement or development, or HUD disposition.
- Veteran of any declared United States war or conflict
- Victim of Domestic Violence (Witness Protection Program)
- Runaway & Homeless Youth Aging out of FOSTER CARE

How to apply:

Persons with disabilities requiring assistance to complete the pre-application may apply in person at 3820 Richfield Rd. Flint, MI 48506, Monday – Friday (excluding holidays) between the hours of 8:30 A.M until 4:30 P.M.

FHC is a federally funded Public Housing Agency which provides housing opportunities for low-income families. Families admitted to FHC's Low-Income Public Housing Program live at one of FHC's public housing communities, which are located in Flint, Michigan. Prior to admission, the FHC verifies the family's income and other household circumstances, including criminal and credit background checks for all adults. Families deemed both eligible and suitable for admission will be offered an opportunity to lease a unit with FHC. Families who lease FHC public housing units have the option of paying either an Income-based Rent (which is 30% of the family's monthly adjusted income) or a Flat Rent (based on the number of bedrooms of the leased unit).
